The following subjects were discussed, and relevant decisions were made as given below:

1.1 Welcome Address by Principal

At the outset, the Principal welcomed the Chairman Dr.K.Ramakrishnan, The Executive Director Dr.S.Kuppusamy and all the esteemed members and thanked them for their kind acceptance as Member of the Governing body of K.Ramakrishnan College of Engineering, Tiruchirappalli (Autonomous). He hoped that their valuable guidance will steer this institute to one of the premier institutes in the field of technical education in our country and the world. This also helps to fulfil the objectives as prescribed by UGC - 2018 guidelines for autonomous colleges. The Committee on its part expressed its wish to actively facilitate development focused on making KRCE an Institute of Excellence in the country.

Introduction about the College:

The K.Ramakrishnan College of Engineering, Tiruchirappalli was established as an affiliated college of Anna University in 2008 to cater the technical manpower of the state with an intake of 240 students i.e. 60 each in Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. During 2011 to 2013 the intake was increased to 60 for each department and started PG programme in M.E Computer Science Engineering, M.E Electronics and Communication Systems, M.E Power Systems Engineering, M.E Engineering Design. The Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme was started in the year 2009. Based on credentials, KRCE is accredited with "A" grade by NAAC and three UG programs (EEE, ECE & MECHANICAL Engineering,) were accredited by NBA.

Recently, UGC/AICTE/ANNA UNIVERSITY recommended autonomous status to KRCE vide their letter No.F.22-1/2017(AC), dated:09.12.2019 for a period of 10 years w.e.f. 2020-2021 academic session as per 2018 autonomy guidelines. Accordingly, the parent university i.e. Anna University Chennai, granted autonomous status for a period of 10 years from



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2020-21 academic session vide their letter no. 4725/AU/CAC/Autonomous/2019 dated:08.01.2020. The Governing Body was constituted vide based on the UGC/AICTE/ANNA UNIVERSITY Orders.

1.2.8 ACADEMIC REGULATIONS:

As per provisions laid down in the UGC/AICTE/ANNA UNIVERSITY guidelines for autonomous colleges, the UG and PG Regulations were prepared and the Academic Council approved the same.

The Governing body ratified and approved the new UG & PG Regulations as per the Academic Council recommendation which have been framed with the changes in Internal and External Mark weightages and introduced double valuation, Supplementary Examination, Special Examination, Value added Courses and Elective papers based on industry needs.

Academic Curriculum & Syllabus:

The Governing body ratified and approved the Curriculum & Syllabus for the Academic batch 2020-21 onwards as per the Academic Council recommendation and approval. All other existing batches will follow the Anna University Curriculum & Syllabus for both UG & PG programmes.

The Curriculum and Syllabi (1st and 2nd Semester) have been framed and introduced Theory cum Lab component for all departments. New Elective Courses such as Intellectual Property Rights and Entrepreneurship Development course and other emerging core papers are included.



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1.2.9 Examination Matters- CoE Manual:

The guidelines under "Scope and Eligibility" read as "Autonomy granted to the Institution is Institutional and cover all courses at all levels". As per the guidelines "The students enrolled at the time of granting autonomy to the College shall also be covered under autonomy." The University will confer the degrees to the students of the Autonomous Colleges. However, the certificates of the students will have the name of the autonomous college inscribed on the certificates. UGC recommended autonomy for 10 years with effect from 2020-21 academic session to 2029-30 which was conferred by the Anna university, Chennai. Based on the UGC letter vide their letter no. F.22-1/2017(AC), dated: 09.12.2019 to the Principal, KRCE, Trichy, which got autonomous status by Anna University, as per UGC-2018 guidelines, the college may follow provisions of UGC guidelines for autonomous colleges with regard to all the batches of students enrolled in the college.

Conduct of Examinations

As per the Anna University letter and UGC guidelines for autonomous colleges 2018, Governing Body approved to conduct all examinations starting from 1st Semester to Final Semester for all the UG and PG programs along with Doctoral course work imparted by KRCE from Academic Year 2020-21.

The Governing Body ratified and approved the COE Manual 2020-2021, as per the Academic Council recommendations.

- The Examination Process will be carried out based on the guidelines of UGC/AICTE/ANNA UNIVERSITY.
- All necessary processes with respect to conduct of examinations like printing of answer booklets, evaluation process, publication of results etc. are to be prescribed by the Academic Council of KRCE on urgent basis.
- Based on the End Semester Examination results, the Anna University will confer the degrees to the students of the Autonomous Colleges. However, the Certificates/Marks Statement of the students will have the name of the autonomous college inscribed on the certificates as per UGC guidelines 2018.
- Due to COVID-19 situation the Governing body ratified and approved the MCQ Proctored type online mode of Examinations.

- ✓ Finally, the meeting was ended with Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr.R.Kamaraj, Head, and Department of MBA.




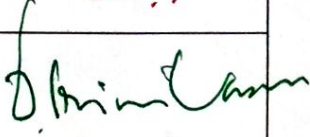

Dr.Lavanam Amballa, suggested to help the students to develop their skills in the emerging areas like, data science, Block chain, Internet of Things, Cloud computing etc. and also suggested to train the students in these fields, to easily get the placement opportunity in IT sector. He Also briefed that there will be a Boom in IT sector for another three to four years.



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Dr.S. Kuppusamy, Executive Director, asked suggestion regarding the Minor degree courses approval which was given by Anna University recently. Dr.Lavanam Amballa, suggested to prepare the curriculum related to the industry needs and insisted to develop skills in IoT and other challenges faced by industry. Also he suggested bringing flexibility in the syllabus to enhance their skills as per the industry requirements.

Dr.S.K.Singh, Professor & Dean, Department of Environmental Engineering, Dean (Alumni Affairs), Delhi Technological University enquired about the new Programmes started and the mode of conducting Regular classes.

Dr.D.Noorullah, Associate Professor, Department of Metallurgical Engineering, Government College of Engineering, Salem, asked about the percentage of students admitted under Government Quota and the Cut off marks of the students admitted in various departments. He also enquired about the GATE and other national level exam training programmes conducted for students. Dr.D.Srinivasan, principal explained about the 7.5 % of the seats filled under Government category and the details of admitted students cut off marks during the last year.

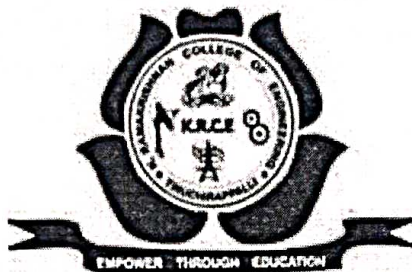
