

ADMISSION POLICY

Objective

The objective of the admission process is to establish a fair, efficient, and standardized system to select qualified candidates for various programs. It is designed to be transparent, equitable, non-discriminatory, and merit-based, providing equal opportunities for all students to pursue higher education in engineering disciplines.

1. Eligibility criteria for UG admission

A pass in the HSC or its equivalent with a minimum average percentage in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together as given below.

a) Academics Subjects

S.No	Community	A Pass with Minimum average marks in PCM
1	General Category	45%
2	BC & BCM	40%
3	MBC & DNC	40%
4	SC / SCA / ST	40%

b) Admission Norms

Admissions are made as per State Government Norms. 65% TNEA Counselling and 35% of Consortium of Self-Financing

2. Eligibility criteria for PG admission

a) M.B.A. Degree Programme:

- A pass in a recognised Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration and obtained at least 50% (45% in the case of BC, BCM, MBC, SC, SCA and ST candidates belonging to Tamilnadu) in the qualifying degree examination.

(a) 10 + 2 + 3 / 4 / 5 years pattern (or)

(b) 10 + 3 years Diploma +2/3 years pattern (or)

(c) (i) 10 + 2 + AMIE* + 2 Yrs of experience (or) (ii) 10 + 3 years diploma (awarded by the State Board of Technical Education) + AMIE* + 2 Yrs of experience

b) M.E. Degree Programme:

(a) A pass in a recognised Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in the relevant field and obtained atleast 50% (45% in the case of BC, BCM, MBC, SC, SCA and ST candidates belonging to Tamilnadu) in the qualifying degree examination.

(i) B.E. / B.Tech. / B.Arch. Degree Programmes (or) (ii) B.Pharm. Degree Programmes (or) (iii) Master's Degree in the relevant branch of Science / Arts, which are prescribed.

(b) (i) 10 + 2 + AMIE* + 2 Yrs of experience (or) (ii) 10 + 3 years diploma (awarded by the State Board of Technical Education) + AMIE* + 2 Yrs of experience
